## ★ READING THE DANCE SCHEDULE

**Staff Callers** – Staff callers are referred to by first name to fit on the schedule.

**Special Callers** – Identified in full, calling something they specialize in.

**GCA Callers** – Members of the Gay Callers Association, who will start the marked hours with a 10-minute tip that matches the program of that hour.

**TNP** (Take No Prisoners) – For experienced dancers of that program. Callers call very difficult DBD from odd positions.

**HH** (Hot Hash) – Faster and flowing dancing with only slightly more difficult choreography (Plus and A2).

**WK** (Workshop) – In-depth session looking at calls or concepts for dancers at that advertised program (i.e., you should know A2 to do the A2 workshop).

### SPECIALTY TIPS - Will be called at the Mainstream level

**Progressive Squares** (Saturday morning) – Part of the opening ceremonies, enjoy the magic as the caller directs the dancers to progress from one square to another, around the room, and end up back at home.

**Memorial** (Saturday morning) – Part of the opening ceremonies, a tip in loving memory of absent friends.

**Women's** (Saturday 11 am) – For those self-identified as women.

**Sexy @ 60** (Saturday 3 pm) – For those in their 60s and up, their friends, admirers, and everyone else.

**Millennial** (Saturday 3 pm) – For dancers under 35.

**Married** (Saturday 3:30 pm) – For married couples.

**Kilt** (Saturday 4 pm) – Opportunity for kilt-wearers to dance together.

**Bears** (Saturday 4:30 pm) – For those of hairy disposition and/or large girth, and their admirers. Bare chests recommended.

**Leather** (Saturday 9:30 pm) – Leather dress code recommended. Major piece of leather or rubber equivalent (e.g. pants, chaps, vest, harness) or disciplined services uniform requested. Bare chest plus black or blue jeans permitted.

**Underpants** (Sunday 9 pm) – Thongs OK, jockstraps too racy.

**Moonshine** (Sunday 10 pm) – (Un)dress code required, footwear recommended for your safety. No alcohol, no cell phones, no photography, no entry after doors close (@ 10:10), bags checked at door.

**Medallion** (Monday 11 am) – In honour of the new recipients of the decade-year medallions, the first tip will be for these recipients only (and as many as needed to fill in the last square).

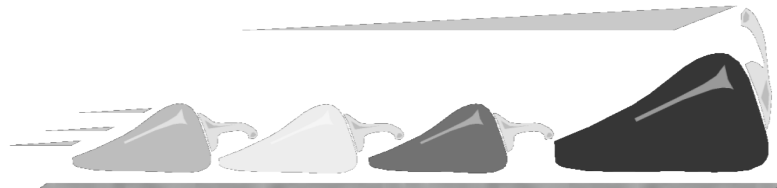
