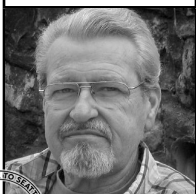



Memorial - A tribute to the dancers who are no longer with us.

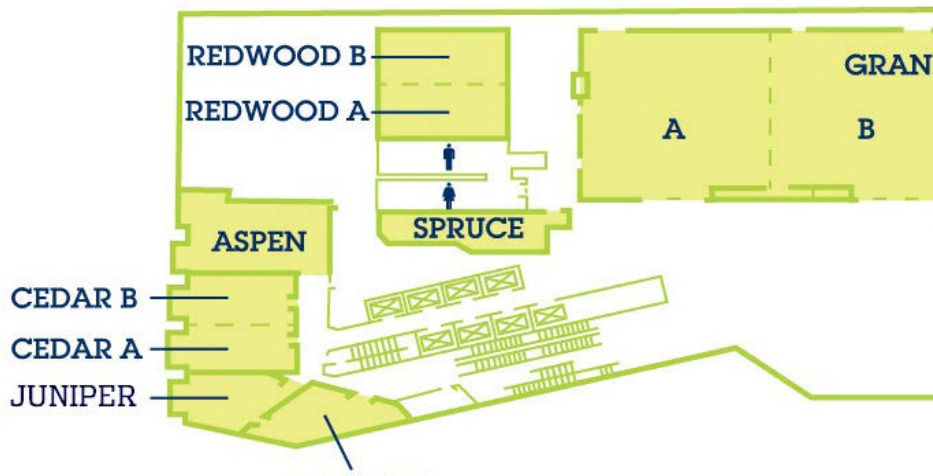
